☆ **FINISHED SIZE:**
8" wide and 134" long.

 **FIBER:**
Louet Dyed Corriedale Roving (100% wool): burnt orange, 1 lb.

 **NEEDLES:**
Size 50 (25 mm): straight. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

☆ **NOTIONS:**
Large crochet hook for weaving in ends.

☆ **GAUGE:**
3½ sts and 6 rows = 4" in garter st.

☆ **SKILL LEVEL:**
Easy  



MYOPIA SCARF

PREPARE ROVING

Divide fiber into two equal widths. Split each half into thirds, so that ultimately you will be working with $\frac{1}{6}$ the width of the roving. Take care to split the fibers as evenly as possible. Join ends by patting and twisting tog to make a long knittable strip.

SCARF

Use the knitted method (see Glossary) to CO 7 sts.

Rows 1-6: Knit.

Row 7: (WS) Purl.

Row 8: (RS) K1, *yo, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Row 9: Purl.

Row 10: *Ssk, yo; rep from *, end k1.

Rows 11-18: Rep Rows 7-10 twice more.

Rows 19-24: Knit.

Row 25: *K1 wrapping yarn around needle 3 times; rep from * across.

Row 26: *K1, dropping 2 extra wraps (creating one elongated st); rep from * across.

Rows 26-30: Knit.

Rep Rows 7-30 four more times. BO all sts kwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends with crochet hook. ■

Knitted Cast-On

Place slipknot on left needle if there are no established stitches. *With right needle, knit into first stitch (or slipknot) on left needle (Figure 1) and place new stitch onto left needle (Figure 2). Repeat from *, always knitting into last stitch made.

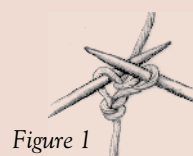

Notions Large crochet hook for weaving in ends.

Gauge $3\frac{1}{2}$ sts and 6 rows = 4" in garter st.
